REAL WORLD NETWORKING TIPS

- 1. It's not the quantity of your network that's important *it's the quality*
- 2. Practice networking (Uber, Waiters & Waitresses)
- 3. Be in the moment (no looking over someone's shoulder to find someone more important to talk to)
- 4. Don't judge a book by it's cover, and don't change the cover of your book *be yourself* (don't change your cover, but if you're not happy with your book, start re-writing it)
- 5. Always be prepared to quit
- 6. Ask for what you want
- 7. Get some *swagger* (the thing that makes you uniquely you)
- 8. BE BOLD
